The Index is more than just a list of course content, check off the hand outs as you work through the course they are in the sessions that they most relate to, however just like in Life they do not stand a lone and they all relate to each other and compliment each other.

And just like in Life they don't always flow from 1 to 14, be prepared **to be** flexible, the course has been designed to be a challenge just like CP.

The PowerPoint and the course work do compliment each other but just like life they catch you out some times.

There is a gradual learning approach that is designed to **compliment you** and the way you look at CP, it is not a do this do that course, it is more of a this is the problem you have the knowledge, **now work it out**, and come up with a solution.

The course has been designed to protect you, as well as the principal.
