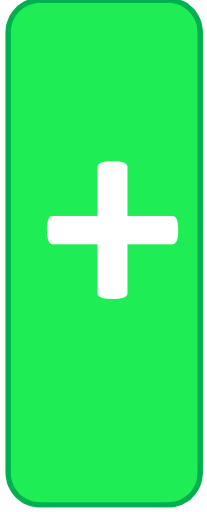


HABC Level 3 Award in First Aid Response (QCF)



Comprehensive understanding of first aid along with an understanding of how important medical/environmental intelligence is when dealing with a range of casualties.

This qualification is the ideal course that can be specifically related to specialist roles such as SIA Close Protection Operatives and SIA licensed Door Supervisors, and SIA licensed Security Operatives and anyone who works in remote areas, hostile environments or where there could be mass casualties. *It meets the SIA requirements for CP licence/renewals first aid qualification and re/qualification.*

The qualification is made up of 3 mandatory units:

Unit 1 – First Aid at Work

- Understand the role and responsibilities of a first aider
- Be able to assess an incident
- Be able to manage an unresponsive casualty who is breathing normally
- Be able to manage an unresponsive casualty who is not breathing normally
- Know how to recognise and assist a casualty who is choking
- Be able to manage a casualty with external bleeding
- Be able to manage a casualty who is in shock
- Be able to manage a casualty with a minor injury
- Be able to conduct a secondary survey.
- Be able to administer first aid to a casualty with injuries to bones, muscles and joints.
- Be able to administer first aid to a casualty with suspected head and spinal injuries.
- Be able to administer first aid to a casualty with suspected chest injuries.
- Be able to administer first aid to a casualty with burns and scalds.
- Be able to administer first aid to a casualty with an eye injury.
- Be able to administer first aid to a casualty with sudden poisoning
- Be able to administer first aid to a casualty with anaphylaxis.
- Be able to provide first aid to a casualty with suspected major illness.

Unit 2 – Medical Intelligence and Environmental Awareness

- Understand how the environment can impact on the provision of first aid
- Understand key medical intelligence which supports the provision of first aid for a specific environment
- Understand how to support a variety of casualties

Unit 3 – Understand the Correct use of an AED

- Understand the safe use of an automated external defibrillator
- Be able to demonstrate basic life support techniques and automated external defibrillator use in line with current national guidelines
- Understand how to carry out basic maintenance and checks of an automated external defibrillator

To be able to complete the course you must attend, comprehend the learning outcomes below and pass all the practical and theoretical aspects required.

Duration of the Course

Our course is delivered over a full 4 days as additional training and practice to include working in hostile environments, the use of tourniquets and hemostatic dressings and includes the assessment requirements of the HABC Level 2 Award in Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation and Automated External Defibrillation (QCF) for which you will be certificated separately.

Entry Requirements

Learners are required to be 16 years of age prior to certification. It is also advised that learners have a minimum of level 1 in literacy and numeracy.

Assessment

1. The qualification is internally assessed by both on-course assessment theory and practical assessment along with some distance study/ assessment that investigates the area of medical intelligence and environmental awareness.

The course includes on-going practical and theoretical learning and assessment and may include some off-course study.

Renewal

In line with industry guidance, the qualification supports/approves first aiders for a period of 3 years, at which point learners will need to re-sit the course, however the recommendation is that learners refresh their knowledge annually.

Progression

Upon successful completion learners may wish to continue their development via the completion of any of the sign-posted qualifications/training:
