Highfield Level 3 Award in Emergency First Aid (RQF)

This qualification is designed for those learners already working or preparing to work in industry and that have been identified within the company's risk assessment of First Aid. It is typically delivered as a one day programme.

The objective of this qualification is to support learners in becoming emergency first aiders in the workplace. The content of the qualification meets the HSE requirements for training emergency first-aiders in those organisations that have identified that staff need to be trained to this level within their first-aid needs assessment.

The qualification covers knowledge such as the roles and responsibilities of the first aider and how to assess an incident. The qualification also covers first aid skills in CPR and use of an AED, providing first aid to a casualty who is choking and dealing with external bleeding and hypovolaemic shock.

In line with guidance provided by the HSE, the qualification supports/approves work place first aiders for a period of 3 years, after which point learners will need to retake the course. In addition to this, it is recommended that learners refresh their knowledge annually.

Automated external defibrillators (AEDs) are extremely straightforward to use and on our course we will give you the skills and confidence to use a defibrillator and perform CPR. Qualification Structure

- be able to manage a casualty who is in shock
- be able to manage a casualty with a minor injury

Entry Requirements

Learners are required to be 16 years of age prior to certification. It is also advised that learners have a minimum of level 1 in literacy and numeracy.

1) Practical observation
