Highfield Level 3 Award in Emergency First Aid (RQF)

This qualification is designed for those learners already working or preparing to work in industry and that have been identified within the company's risk assessment of First Aid. It is typically delivered as a one day programme (6hrs). Its also meet the SIA entry requirements for First Aid and Top Up training for security officers/door supervisors.

The objective of this qualification is to support learners in becoming emergency first aiders in the workplace. The content of the qualification meets the HSE requirements for training emergency first-aiders in those organisations that have identified that staff need to be trained to this level within their first-aid needs assessment.

The qualification covers knowledge such as the roles and responsibilities of the first aider and how to assess an incident. The qualification also covers first aid skills in CPR and use of an AED, providing first aid to a casualty who is choking and dealing with bleeding and shock, burns, severe allergies (Anaphylaxis) and how to deal with minor injuries such as nose bleeds, splinters etc.

In line with guidance provided by the HSE, the qualification supports/approves workplace first aiders for a period of 3 years, after which point learners will need to retake the course. In addition to this, it is recommended learners refresh their knowledge annually.

Automated external defibrillators (AEDs) are extremely straightforward to use and on our course we will give you the skills and confidence to use an AED and perform basic life saving skills. We can also advise your business on the appropriate risk assessments required for first aid and on the purchase of AEDs.

Qualification Structure

This qualification consists of one mandatory unit, which you must complete successfully in order to achieve the qualification:

- be able to assess an incident
- be able to manage an unresponsive casualty who is breathing normally
- be able to manage an unresponsive casualty who is not breathing normally
- know how to recognise and assist a casualty who is choking
- be able to manage a casualty with external bleeding
- be able to manage a casualty who is in shock
- be able to manage a casualty with a minor injury

Entry Requirements

Learners are required to be 16 years of age prior to certification. It is also advised that learners must have a minimum of level 1 in literacy reading, writing, speaking and listening.

Assessment

The qualification is assessed by the following two methods:

1) Practical observation

The practical assessment is completed throughout the course delivery. This ongoing assessment requires learners to demonstrate practical first aid skills.

2) Centre-marked multiple-choice theory assessment

Learners are required to answer a series of multi-choice questions to test their knowledge.

The qualification is valid for a period of 3 years, after which point learners will need to retake the course. In addition to this it is recommended that learners refresh their knowledge annually.
